Montville and Searsmont are adjoining towns in Waldo County, Maine. Montville was incorporated in 1807, and Searsmont in 1814. Searsmont school district #14 was in North Searsmont while the Montville district #20 was in South Montville. Apparently the two districts contributed to a joint fund, supported a joint school, and held joint meetings during this period.
