From Williamson's History of the City of Belfast, V.2 :

"The Belfast Scientific Association, for the purpose of pursuing scientific studies, was organized April 11, 1887, with Rev. John Arthur Savage as president, and Charles Swan Bickford as Secretary. The room was in the attic story of the Savings Bank Building. A collection of specimens was made, and lectures frequently delivered. No meetings were held after 1893." Other members of the society included Joseph Williamson, Joseph Williamson, Jr., H.L. Woodcock, Charles Coombs, Benjamin Hazeltine, Fred Chase, W. R. Marshall, George Tuffts, W.C. Crawford, C.A. Pillsbury, Horatio H. Johnson, Joseph B. Pendleton, and others.
