

Addendum to Abbott Room Policy

Policy Governing Abbott Room Piano

The Steinway grand piano in the Abbott Room is generally located at the back of the stage next to the wall where its humidifier is plugged in at all times. It is kept closed, covered, and locked when not in use.

GROUPS PAYING USER FEES (key available from librarian):

Moving the piano: Unplug the humidifier system and tuck cord away to avoid rolling over the plug.

Uncover after moving piano into the desired position. Stabilize using metal U-shaped stops around the wheels.

Do not place any objects on the piano.

After use, remove wheel blocks, cover, return to its position at the back of the stage; plug in humidifier, and lock. Return key to librarian.

Tuning: Tuning is at the expense of the group using the piano. In order assure proper care, the library has designated an official piano technician, Brian Catell, of the Catell Piano Shop, 681 Ohio Street, Bangor (947-8413), to service the piano. Please contact him several weeks in advance to schedule an appointment.

NON-USERS:

Do not move the piano unless permission has been granted by the librarian.

Do not remove the piano cover.

Do not place objects of any kind on top of the piano.

Any special requests which deviate from these rules should be discussed with the librarian.
